PM summary

The audit found 8 accessibility issues. Prioritize critical and high-severity fixes before release, then address medium issues that affect navigation, labeling, and structure.

CRITICAL issues

Low inline color contrast - WCAG 2.1 1.4.3

Selector: div

Inline foreground/background colors have contrast ratio 2.54:1, below the 4.5:1 target.

Fix: Adjust text or background color to increase contrast ratio.

HIGH issues

Missing document title - WCAG 2.1 2.4.2

Selector: head > title

The page is missing a meaningful <title> element.

Fix: Add a concise page title that describes the current document.

Image missing alt text - WCAG 2.1 1.1.1

Selector: img

An image element has no alt attribute.

Fix: Add alt text, or use alt="" for decorative images.

Form control missing accessible label - WCAG 2.1 1.3.1

Selector: input

A form field has no visible label or accessible name.

Fix: Associate a `<label>`, `aria-label`, or `aria-labelledby` with the control.

Interactive element missing text alternative - WCAG 2.1 4.1.2

Selector: a

A link or button has no readable text or `aria-label`.

Fix: Add visible text or `aria-label` describing the action.

MEDIUM issues

Missing document language - WCAG 2.1 3.1.1

Selector: html

The root `<html>` element has no `lang` attribute.

Fix: Set `lang` on the `html` element, for example `<html lang="en">`.

Missing main landmark - WCAG 2.1 1.3.1

Selector: body

The document has no `<main>` landmark or `role="main"`.

Fix: Wrap the primary page content in `<main>` or assign `role="main"`.

Missing H1 heading - WCAG 2.1 1.3.1

Selector: body

No top-level heading was found on the page.

Fix: Add a single descriptive `<h1>` for the main page topic.
